# About the Consortium

Brandeis University is part of a consortium consisting of Boston College, Boston University, Tufts University (excluding Fletcher School), Bentley College, Babson College, Regis College, the Department of Urban Studies and Planning at MIT, and the Gerontology Department at the University of Massachusetts, Boston.

When registering for a course at one of the consortium schools during the Fall and/or Spring semesters, Heller students do not have to pay tuition there, but must pay full tuition at Brandeis (this is because the consortium schools have a tuition-sharing agreement).

# **Registration Process for Consortium Courses**

To register for a course at one of the consortium schools you must:

- 1. Add the course to your ILP and meet with your advisor to discuss the course and obtain approval. Your adviser may ask to see the syllabus at this point if needed to determine whether the course supports your educational goals. Outside courses may not be used to substitute for similar courses offered in the Heller School's curriculum. Bring your signed ILP to Norma.
- 2. Talk to the Assistant Dean for Student Records (Ravi) to see whether you are eligible to take that particular course. Some graduate programs in some consortium schools may not allow cross-registration or some courses may not be available for cross registration.
- 3. Obtain permission from the consortium school instructor to take his or her course. You do not have to wait until the registration period to contact the instructor.
- 4. During the registration period, obtain a cross-registration form from the Brandeis registrar's office in Kutz. You will need four signatures on this form: the Brandeis registrar (which you can get when you pick up the form), Ravi (the form says graduate program advisor but in this case it means Ravi), the host institution's registrar and the instructor.
- 5. Once you've obtained the two Brandeis signatures, you can get the instructor's signature and the syllabus on the first day of class. Then take the form to be signed by the Registrar of the consortium school where the course is offered. They will keep once copy of the form.
- 6. Return the signed cross-registration form and the course syllabus to the Brandeis Registrar's office in Kutz before the end of the registration period.

## Rules

1. Students may take a maximum of two courses at consortium schools and a maximum of one per semester. Exceptions to the total number of consortium courses may be made by the program.

- 2. Consortium privileges do not run in the summer. Students taking a course at a school other than Brandeis over the summer are responsible for paying tuition to that school.
- 3. Consortium courses are available to full-time students only.
- 4. Students may not replace core required classes with a consortium course.
- 5. It is the student's responsibility to make sure that the instructor meets Heller's grade posting deadline, particularly in their final semester.
- 6. We do not recommend that you take a consortium class during your first semester.
